



## Takara Belmont and California's Prop 65 Labeling Requirements

California Proposition 65 is an initiative to address concerns about potential exposure to toxic chemicals and thus requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians for products sold that may contain stated chemicals or ingredients. The warnings are intended to help Californians make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals from the products they use and the places they go.

Because there is always a chance that wood dust, phthalates or other ingredients included in the Proposition 65 list are present on the Takara Belmont equipment or packing materials, and because California is very litigious, we have decided to provide Proposition 65 warnings for Takara Belmont products here and with the product:

**“WARNING: Cancer and Reproductive Harm -- [www.P65Warnings.ca.gov](http://www.P65Warnings.ca.gov)”**

Ideally, Takara Belmont would have provided warnings only for the products being shipped to California. However, since they often stock products and do not know exactly where those items will be shipping, they have no alternative except to provide warnings for all our products.

When used as intended and disposed of properly at the end of their working life, Takara Belmont products are safe for consumers and pose no greater risk to human health and the environment than many other consumer goods available that contain wood, polyurethane foam, vinyl fabric, plastics, steel, brass, aluminum, and other like materials.
