- 1. Remove the eight screws and metal sleeves from the ends of the support rods and set them aside.
- 2. Position the two cart frames so that the large holes face outward.
- 3. Align the four support rods with the corresponding holes on the frames. Ensure the small holes on the cart frames are facing inward.
- 4. Reinsert the eight previously removed screws through the metal sleeves and into the aligned holes on the work cart frames.
- 5. Use the included wrench to loosely secure the support rods into place.
- 6. Important: Do not fully tighten the eight screws at this stage. Leave them slightly loose to allow for adjustment during later assembly steps.

Step 2






- 1. Position the two drawers on top of the support rods assembled in Step 1.
- 2. Make sure both drawers are properly centered on the frame.
- 3. Once aligned, use the provided wrench to tighten all eight screws securely from Step 1.

Step 3






 Use the provided eight self-tapping screws to attach the drawers to the cart frame. Insert the screws through the pre-drilled holes using a Phillips-head screwdriver. This will keep the drawers stable and prevent slipping.

Step 4







- 1. Place the cart on its side on a flat, stable surface and locate the four pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the cart frame.
- 2. Insert one caster into each hole and turn it until fully attached and secured.
- 3. Ensure all casters are securely attached and rotate smoothly. If the cart is unbalanced, adjust the caster heights as needed to level the cart.
